Mandate from heaven:

THE RED FLAG OF FAITH

Richard Shakarian, International President

At thirty thousand feet over the Caribbean, flying home from a planning trip, I was struck by the openness of the people all over the nation of Honduras to accept the Lord. Whenever we asked people to come to Christ, they willingly and gladly gave their hearts to God. Such hunger for God I have never seen before in my life.

I prayed, "Lord, You told me to reach one million people, one person in every family in the nation. They are open, but the 3500 meetings being put together for our Fire Teams is not enough to reach a million people. You would not have told me to reach someone in every family if it was not possible. Lord, what are we supposed to do?"

It was then that the Lord took me back to Joshua when they were about to destroy the big walls of Jericho. These walls represented sin, iniquity and bondage. There was one lady in that city, Rahab, the harlot, who said, "I've heard of your God and we know that He is powerful in heaven and He is powerful on earth. I want my family to be saved." She was told, "Take a red cloth and when our soldiers are coming into the city, put the red cloth in front of your home, hang it out the window and every one in your home will be saved."

The Lord instructed me, "Go to Honduras early. Take this message to the television stations; declare to the people throughout the land that they should give a signal of faith to God,

and a signal to our Fire Team soldiers that they want their family to be saved and their business to be blessed.

I landed back in Tegucigalpa several days later. Immediately the Holy Spirit took charge of my entire agenda. Within one day, I found myself on national television, one of the most powerful secular stations. For twelve days in row, twice a day, on news shows and on talk shows, I gave the message of hope, "You have suffered greatly, and God has heard your cries. You've had Hurricane Mitch, deflation, business failures, bank failures, hospital closings, crime, floods, and famine. God has heard your cries, and He has come to deliver you. He sends us to give you the message of hope, that from this day on God is going to bless this nation. We are here with five thousand men and women, in

one thousand Fire Teams, in 3,500 meetings, in every part of Honduras.”

“It may be difficult for you to get through to us on the phone, or to contact us in person, or for us to find your place. So if you are not already scheduled for one of those meetings, and you would like your family to be saved, then take the same signal that this lady in the Bible did. Take any piece of red cloth and put it in front of your door, in your window, in front of your house, in front of your business. It

will be a signal to God, for God's blessing, and as our Fire Teams are going down the street, when they see your signal, they will come and pray for you."

"The last time it was done in a nation was over 3000 years ago when the great deliverer, Moses, told the nation of Israel (who was in slavery at that time in Egypt) that God was going to bring them out of slavery, poverty, and bondage. Take the blood of the lamb, which stands for the blood of Jesus Christ and put it on your door post, put it up above your door. Take this red cloth and put it up there. It is a signal to God of your faith, and if you do this God will bring you out of bondage. A few days later they were brought out of bondage with silver and gold, and not a feeble one among them. Slaves are poor, but God forced their enemies to give them silver and gold. Slaves do not have good health but He fed them and He gave them their strength and health."

"Today most of your hospitals are closed down because of strikes, but I want you to



know that the Healer is not on strike. Today I saw on the news that many of the small banks have been closed and many of you have lost all your money, but He that provides the silver and gold to this world is still in business. And He has got the power to bring deliverance to you today. Put up your red flag of faith and our Fire Teams will come and pray for your business and for your home." ✨

From the very first meeting I was very surprised about how the people here were prepared by the Holy Spirit to receive Jesus Christ. We only opened our mouths and told them that we have come to bring them the Savior, Jesus Christ.

It was incredible to see it. We were like fishermen, where the fish were jumping into the boat. The only thing we had to do was to receive them. I have never seen a country so open and prepared.

In one auditorium people were lined up and waiting to get into the office. We asked them to listen to us because we were Christian businessmen coming from Germany. Two ladies gave testimonies of healing. We then asked if any one wanted to be healed to come to the front for prayer. A 65-year-old man stood up and said that he was suffering from asthma. We immediately prayed for him. He then said, "I feel better; it is gone! It is gone!"

In Honduras we went to the people. That is where the bless-

ing is. We went to the companies, the offices and the work places. We were able to share about are experiences in Jesus Christ everywhere, it seemed like no door was closed. It was incredible!

Our team returned home to Germany with new vision for our own country. I believe that the future is going to include many people coming to Jesus. Our job is to go to them right in the middle of their everyday lives.

In Honduras we saw miracles of healing. It was amazing to see how the people were open to the healing power of the Holy Spirit. You could sense how God was moving. Jesus said there would be streams of living waters flowing from those who put their trust in Him.

I thank the Lord God for all He did. There are so many testimonies, we could write a book about all that we have seen during this one week. It was not because we are such holy people that God did such things; it was only by His grace. He opened the hearts by the prayers of many people.

Based on written reports submitted to our office after each meeting, we have calculated that 326,800 people made a commitment to Jesus Christ during the Fire Team outreach in Honduras. And this number does not take into account those who responded to testimonies broadcast over radio and television every day.

When FGBMFI International President, Richard Shakarian, told us about his vision to reach one person in every family, we were overwhelmed by the magnitude of this task.


Nevertheless, in the belief that it was from God, we went to work in prayer and planning. In doing so, God gave us a plan to have at least 3000 meetings throughout the nation. By the time the five-day outreach was over this number had grown to almost 3500 meetings in businesses, factories, government offices, and universities.

On Saturday evening we had a victory celebration. In my city a procession of 100

cars drove around the city seven times, blowing their horns, waving red faith banners, and shouting proclamations of victory. After the 6th time around, a beautiful rainbow appeared in a complete circle around the sun. We knew that God was pleased with our work in Honduras.

My question to you is, “Where else could you literally impact every level of society?” God said by His Spirit that “this Fellowship will be used mightily in the last days to bring in the Harvest” and that “the latter days will be greater than the former days even though we have been around almost 50 years.” We are just beginning to fulfill the vision that God gave Demos many years ago.

The English language lacks the words to say how absolutely wonderful the Honduras outreach was – to be used by God and see thousands of people come to know Him as their Lord and Savior.

We are beginning to know the strength of simply sharing our personal testimony.

The Air Force

I spent almost 4 years in the Air Force, so felt fortunate to go to the Air Force Base in Honduras. I shared about how I'd lost everything and had had to start over again. I asked them if they were interested in knowing Jesus as their Lord and Savior. They said "Yes!"

There were four to five hundred men who came for prayer. These men were very sincere. It was beautiful! The Chief of Staff for the Armed Forces, the C.O. for the Air Force and five other of the highest ranking officers were present.

We went to a T-shirt factory. There were about 300 ladies in the area, as well as people outside, in the kitchen, and in the bathrooms listening.

I shared how God healed my 14-month-old daughter of cerebral palsy. When I told them that Christ healed my baby and asked them if they wanted to know this Jesus, virtually every person in the room stood up. It was just plain incredible!

Television

I was so pleased to be with Vangie Shakarian on television. Towards the end, the lady who was interviewing me looked at me in the eyes and asked, "Are you telling me that this Jesus really made a difference in your life? This is something I have to try, too."

I felt the presence of God was with me and it lifted me completely above all the things on this earth. It was an absolute privilege to be used in this way.

In the Colleges

There were a lot of kids who came forward for prayer. Some were weeping. One of them came over to me and said, "Thank you very much for coming and asking us to pray. I was at the point where I did not know what to do. God answered my prayer."

Another person explained that his father was an alcoholic. He asked me to go and pray for his dad. I did and the family of that man was reconciled.

We would start early in the morning and go till late at night. It was exciting, just being involved to the point that you could not even count how many people you were able to impact. I would estimate that I, myself, was able to lead at least 400 people to the Lord. It was unbelievable!

Jimmy Hughes made arrangements for 34 of us to go into the federal prisons or the national prisons where there were over 2000 prisoners. We had an interview with the warden. The visit was broadcast on national television. It was a very special moment. The most exciting time there was when I had the opportunity to witness to the meanest, most violent and worst prisoners in the nation.

A visit like this has never been done before, because the prisons are very delicate. We were allowed to drive right up to the front gate. The officials, all the administration, and policemen

were touched by the testimonies. A few months earlier a gang uprising had resulted in a massacre. We were able to go to the most notorious and the most dangerous of the gangs in Honduras. We brought the love of Jesus. It brought tears into everybody's eyes.

We were given total cooperation. It was amazing! Most of these gang people in prisons are tattooed from their face down. It is sad and devastating to see such diabolic, satanic


things on their bodies. Several of the boys had made a deal with satan and they have tattooed on their forehead 666, representing their street gang and a symbol of the antichrist.

Still, when we preached the gospel of Jesus and shared our testimonies with those young kids, they saw the love of God and opened the doors of their hearts to receive Jesus, and even asked if we could get some machines to erase the satanic tattoos off their faces.

They are risking their lives. It could cost them everything to accept Jesus. The gangs have rules and they do not accept Jesus. In the gangs

they have made a deal with the devil to be violent and destructive.

Yet even under such circumstances the power and the love of God gets through. The man with 666 on his forehead committed his life to Jesus Christ. We will be going back there for follow up.

The love of God penetrates the most ugly circumstances we could imagine.

An Historic Event...

Not since the days of the apostles have ordinary men reached an entire nation in only 7 days. 1,000 Fire Teams in 3,500 meetings from the Congress to the military, from businesses to the universities... from TV news shows... national radio... the Good News went forth.

We are awestruck by the grace of God! What a week it was! What can you say when everyone in the nation is impacted? What can you say when hundreds of thousands of people receive Christ and almost no one turns down the Lord?

At 2 a.m., beneath the starry sky in front of a great mansion, we found ourselves praying the sinner's prayer with three brothers that are among the wealthiest men in the nation. As I looked up into the stars, I couldn't help remembering that just two hours before we had been praying with twelve people, a lowly fisherman, his wife, son and nine employees, among the poorest people in the nation. How humbly they stood, tears coming down their cheeks; it seemed their faces changed like angels.

At the University a young lady gave a folded

note to one of our Fire Team leaders. She said, "I don't need this anymore." It was a suicide note. It said, "Dear Pappa, Dear Mamma, I love you very much, but I have no hope. That's why today is my last day." She had told her friend she would kill herself that day, but instead our Fire Team brought her a message of hope. She received the Lord and no longer needed the note.

The doctors' offices were jammed with people because the nation's hospitals were on strike. At one point a doctor came out of his examination room and asked a nurse, "Where are all the patients? This room was jammed with patients only an hour ago." She said, "I am sorry, Doctor, but the men from the Full Gospel Business Men came and prayed for the patients. They all left!"

Congress invited me to speak. After my message they gave a standing ovation. Many declared their faith in Christ.

The Defense Minister and Chief of Staff called a special meeting of all the High Command. About 150 men stood

with me as we prayed the sinner's prayer.


Then we went on to the military academy, and the Air force. From there we took a helicopter ride to the other side of the nation to the 105th Brigade. Through the television news and talk shows, there were thousands of commitments to Christ.

We went to people in factories, stores, universities, prisons, hospitals, military bases, in businesses, in the market place, and in government departments. Meetings were conducted where businessmen, forgiven by Christ, gave their own story. The effect was electric as scores of individuals in each place received the Lord.

Churches in Nicaragua are jammed with new people. That is the latest word we are receiving from our first nation-wide outreach, which we had there

last year. During that one week 97,000 received the Lord. With our continued work that number is now over 250,000.


We are believing that the final count in Honduras will be over 1 million people. That will mean we are impacting at least one person for every family in the Nation!

We were in a massive event in the classroom, then they called schools to get together. As a result, I spoke to about 10,000 young people in one day. Since then principals of schools throughout the country have been calling us to come back to the colleges and open chapters.

Seven years ago the cattle and rice businesses were doing great, but I could not say that much for my family life. My marriage was on the rocks and I was about to get divorced. About that time a man came to my office and invited me to something called the FGBMFI. He explained that they were businessmen who'd found answers in Jesus Christ.

Well, with my marriage in the shape it was, I knew I needed help, so I went. Jesus changed my life that morning.

God protected me over the years even before I committed my life to Him. On one business trip I remember having partied too much. I was attacked by some thieves, who threatened to kill me. At that point my life was so messed up, but God has since restored my family and brought me the one thing that seemed so elusive - happiness.


We have come to the point where we pray about every aspect of our lives, even the business. When Hurricane Mitch hit we could have lost everything. I prayed for God's protection. Many people lost businesses and houses. We

have 17 companies in different parts of the country and didn't lose anything. We didn't lose as much as a grain of rice!

We felt God saying we should move our cows into the mountains. We did that and not one cow was harmed. It was a miracle. Since that time I have made sure to invest back into God's business, because He saved mine.

Jesus did in my life what was impossible for me to do. He gave me power to change. He gave me peace. He is the only hope for mankind. Jesus is the only guarantee that man has. He is my health, my security, my protection, my everything. Wealth can solve some problems, but people get fooled into thinking it is the answer to all their problems. It is not true; money can not buy everything. Eternal happiness comes from Jesus. In God's economy, there is no limit. The Lord is not against wealth, but He wants your heart first and He wants you to use all He has given you for the good of others and His kingdom.

There came a point in my life when I said, "Lord God, take it all. I give my businesses to you. I give you everything." That was just what He was waiting for. My father is more than 70 years old. One year ago the first Central American Fire Team outreach took place. It has changed our way of working; it has changed our vision. The effect of the outreach has not stopped at our borders. Nation by nation, people are trying to import this type of outreach.

In looking back, we see that this last year has produced more fruit for the FGBMFI in Nicaragua than our entire history with the Fellowship to that time. We now see that this is really what the vision was always all about – going to the people. In the book, “The Happiest People on Earth”, we read about the “sleeping giant” waking up. This is referring to people in the market place reaching out to people like themselves with the reality that they have personally experienced in Jesus.

As FGBMFI International President, Richard Shakarian, puts it, “We need to break out of the confines of the hotels.” Our men are witnessing miracles on a regular basis. This is a whole new move of the Holy Spirit. We are praying


that it keeps growing around the world. In Honduras they had more people working, and the result was even greater than what we saw in Nicaragua.

At the university in Tegucigalpa, I shared my simple story with psychology students. Many began to cry and many came to invite Jesus Christ into their lives. It was a breakthrough event for the university. We saw the same thing in factories, offices, and other places of work. God is doing something special.

At the high schools we saw hundreds of young people make commitments to Jesus Christ. I remember one student in particular. She didn't want any prayer; rather, she wanted to pray for us, that we would keep going with our message of hope. After that meeting I was alone with a group of North Americans. Looking at what God had just done was almost more than we could take.

Then, at a factory, a Guatemalan shared his testimony. When he began, the people looked on with stone cold faces, but by the time we were finished they had changed. When I was a young boy, my parents were divorced. By the time I was thirteen, anger toward my father was beginning to build in my heart. I felt frustrated inside and this began to show up in my school work. My inner turmoil began to increase, and I was near depression. I felt that no one really loved me, so I began looking for friends to fill the void. Unfortunately, they were not the kind of friends I need-

ed, and I began to get into trouble. My schoolwork suffered and continued to be neglected.

My friends and I began to try alcohol, which made my father very angry and rather perplexed at my changing behavior. Soon I was drinking every weekend, and before long I started drinking every day as well. It helped me to feel better. Unfortunately, I continued to drive after drinking and was responsible for several accidents while under the influence of alcohol. While I was drinking I would do things and go places where I never should have been, and because of that was involved in many very negative situations.

After a while, I began to feel that there was no way out of the terrible life I had created for myself. I was uncomfortable with myself and unhappy about every area of my life. I didn't want to work. My disrespectful responses to my father were undeserved. My poor mother was

very sad because I never bothered to go see her. I had basically abandoned her.

Then one day my stepfather invited me to a meeting of the Full Gospel Business Men. I agreed to go. That day is still very clear in my memory. When I cracked open the door, I did not know the surprise God had in store for me. I felt so much love in that meeting! Listening to the testimony and sensing the love all around me touched me deep inside my being. They were talking about Jesus in a way I had never heard before. I remember that I felt as if Jesus was very close to me; it was unlike anything I had ever felt before. I had always believed that there was a God, but not a God like I know today, not a friend.

Then the person leading the meeting asked those who would like to know this friend to come to the altar. I raced to the front and told him I wanted to receive Jesus into my life. Then I said a prayer. In that very moment I

could sense a big war going on inside of me. At one point I fell onto the floor; then I felt all the pain I had been carrying in my chest leave my body. Instead I felt very peaceful. It was as if a great wave of love engulfed me. It was at that moment that I met Jesus Christ, and my relationship with Him began. Since then He has been changing my life, little by little each day.


A hunger for God began to grow in me. I wanted to get to know Him better; I wanted to serve Him. Every time I heard about a gathering I would go. I also started attending conventions of the Full Gospel Business Men's Fellowship. Little



by little, my problems began to go away. The Lord put a new feeling about life into my heart. He gave me a joy that I had not experienced before.

At that moment I didn't know that the Lord had some plans for my life. At a convention in Nicaragua in 1996, when I heard the national president of Costa Rica speak about one university chapter, the Lord put fire into my heart. I knew then that we needed to form chapters for young people in our country. We needed to take what we had received from Him through the Full Gospel Business Men and spread it to millions of people around the country and around the world. He placed that same fire into

the heart of someone else as well so that we could work together. God directed me to start an FGBMFI chapter of young people in San Pedro. That chapter and others are growing very well. There are many young people attending the chapters. The commitment of the chapter is that these young people can come to know and serve Jesus more and more.

As in everyone's life, I also have my problems, but in every difficulty I face, Jesus is there with me. One time I had a very severe illness in my left eye, and the doctor told me he couldn't do anything to really help me. I was losing my sight in that eye. It was very hard for me and I began to turn to Jesus even more than normal. Eventually I was able to go to a hospital in the United States. I was so thankful to God to be able to go. After only a few days I left the hospital healthy and well. Even the doctors were very amazed! This was confirmation to me of God's love. Nobody has ever loved me as much as Jesus does.

As an architect things were going well for me. I was a good family man and respected in my professional life. Nevertheless, there was another side. Like so many other businessmen, I led a double life. The one was a good life and the other was "dark". The problem with this kind of living is that sooner or later it will destroy you and that is what happened to me. My wife and I separated. She went home to Guatemala and we were separated for more a year.

It was devastating; I had lost those I loved the most. When my mother brought me a Bible, I wanted to read it, because I needed something. I read about a man called Saul. He was a man who persecuted Christians. At one point they changed his name to Saint Paul. I reasoned that if this man could be a saint, maybe there was hope for me.

When the divorce papers were ready, my wife came to Honduras. She looked so beautiful; something had changed in her. I asked her what had happened. She said that it was

Jesus Christ. With that I asked, "Do you really want to get divorced?" She answered, "No!" With this monumental decision, we began our family again. This time it was different. Things were not going well in the business, but I knew what was important.

A friend invited us to a weekend retreat, and I committed my life to Jesus there. It was just what I needed. There was no question - I needed Jesus in my life. There were many things that had to change. God worked in my life, changing it one thing at a time. It was a real struggle for me, and at the time when I began to lose the fight, I came in contact with the FGBMFI. There I met men just like me, and they had victory in their lives. This was just the encouragement I needed to grow in an intimate relationship with Jesus Christ.

Recently, in "Fire 2000", we Honduran people received so many blessings from other nations. I had the privilege to translate for men from Houston, Texas, and Lynden, Washington. I could hear the voice of God speaking through these men. During this event some of the men prayed with my wife and she received the Baptism of the Holy Spirit. This was the most wonderful thing of them all. We learned how much we need each other.

The most important thing we learned during "Fire 2000" was that we need to go out of normal chapter meetings. In the hotels we spend a lot and receive little, whereas in the factories, businesses, and universities we accomplish so very much and the cost is little. We need to go out to the people in the power of the Holy Spirit.


We went to an Emergency Help Service similar to the Red Cross. Every day those young

people deal with life and death situations. I could see in their eyes that they were thinking, "These hallelujah men, what do they know? We work with death every day." When Blair Scott began to speak, the Holy Spirit touched a man near us and he began to cry. The hard cold atmosphere melted away and people began to not only listen, but to receive from God.

Before we were done we prayed for almost every person in the room. As God touched their hearts, some would break down sobbing out of control, others would light up with joy. One girl came for prayer and the Holy Spirit showed us that she had been "violated". She received the Holy Spirit and was healed.

At our last meeting Blair and I went to a tortilla factory. We were tired and the atmosphere was cold and hard. There were problems

in the relationship between management and workers and we could feel the tension. We agreed that we would share a short testimony, say a prayer, and leave.

When we finished they offered us a coca cola and, as we began to talk in a casual way, the Holy Spirit came and we began to prophesy. By the time we left, we had prayed for each person, the workers had prayed for the bosses and they had prayed for the workers. They have set up a meeting each Saturday. Liberation came to that factory. 

There was an impact at every level of the society.
